

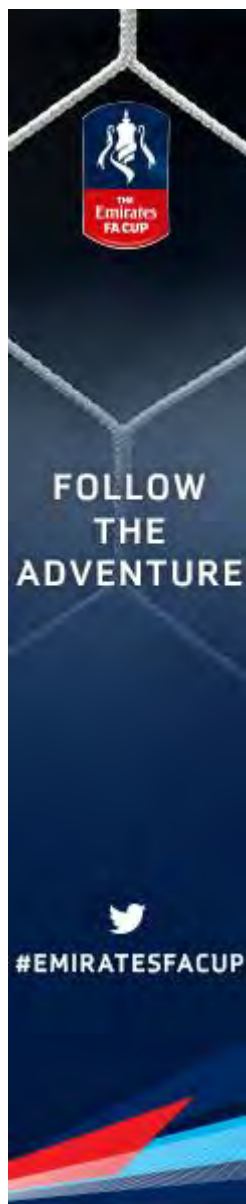

Some high scoring games saw nine member clubs advance to the 2nd qualifying round of the FA Vase with Clapton having to try again this Tuesday, 13th September.

Ex-ESL side Saffron Walden Town, were the only Thurlow Nunn side to enjoy a victory over one of our member clubs with a 2-1 win at Stansted. Enfield enjoyed their sea-side trip to advance at the expense of FC Clacton and Sporting Bengal United saw off Stowmarket Town, 2-1, with a late extra-time winner. Wadham Lodge recorded their maiden FA Vase victory with an impressive 2-1 win against The Dragons of Wivenhoe Town.

London Bari disposed of lower level Olympian One side Newbury Forest (3-0) whilst Ilford needed Extra-Time to see off their Step-Six opponents Harpenden Town (3-1) and Burnham Ramblers put their troubled league season behind them to grab a morale boosting 2-1 win over Hertfordshire County Premier side London Lions.

In the all-Essex Senior league clashes, Redbridge saw off Eton Manor (AET), winning by the odd goal in nine. Southend Manor progressed into the next round by recording a record 7-0 win against West Essex at Southchurch Park. Takely also progressed with a record-breaking win (7-2) at the expense of Tower Hamlets; a match which saw hat-trick hero Charlie Cole having to wait for a whole three minutes before he made his first strike.

In the league, Waltham Forest, who got back to winning ways after their midweek defeat to Stansted, took the points in a 7-goal thriller against FC Romania and Barkingside moved up to fourth when they stung Basildon United. Despite a 2-1 loss at the hands of Sawbridgeworth Town, who only managed at 2-2 draw at Haringey & Waltham during the week, Hullbridge Sports remain at the summit ahead of Takeley on goal difference.

Other mid-week results saw Enfield 1893 increase Burnham Ramblers' pain as they scored three without reply and high fliers Hullbridge Sports and Takeley record 2-1 victories against Redbridge and Southend Manor respectively whilst in the FA Youth Cup Redbridge, Hullbridge Sports and Barking all bowed out at the Preliminary stage.

Matt Keiller converted from close range on 12 minutes and then Eamon Payne added a second three minutes later with a pinpoint header. Michael Hopkins added a third midway through the first half and then it was four when Daniel Okah converted from close range after good work from Callum Ibe. And it was five in first half stoppage time when fantastic football from the hosts ended with Hopkins in to lob over keeper Stephen Reynolds and totally kill off the tie with a half to spare. The second half was fairly flat until the final ten minutes when substitute Rhys Fatt got through before slotting home in off the post and then soon after things got a little silly when first of all West Essex player Oz Stroud received a straight red for a poor challenge and then two minutes later Manor's winger Aundre Spencer was dismissed for dissent. Manor though did add a late seventh when another substitute Abiola Tanimowo got through and slotted home to complete the rout for the hosts. (By Pete Dudley)
