In their inaugural season in the Buildbase FA Vase, Wadham Lodge became the first Essex Senior League side to reach the 1<sup>st</sup> Round proper of this seasons' competition when they defeated Enfield 1893 on Friday night (23<sup>rd</sup> Sept).

There were a further seven games involving ten member clubs on Saturday with four clubs progressing to the competition proper.

Iford were the highest scorers of the day as they put four past compatriots Burnham Ramblers without reply. After being 3-0 up at half-time, Sporting Bengal United survived a late surge from Sawbridgeworth Town to reach the first round for the sixth time since they first entered the competition in 2004. In the third and final all-ESL game, London Bari needed extra-time to get past Barkingside and progress to the competition proper for the first time in their history. High-flying Waltham Forest were the fourth team through but they left it late when they scored the winner in the 93<sup>rd</sup> minute against Thurlow Nunn Hadleigh United.

The biggest shock of the day was at Southchurch Park where, after a goal-less 120 minutes, Southend Manor were knocked out by Canning Town of the Prokit Essex Olympian League (step 7) in the 'lottery' of penalty kicks. Takeley fared little better when they went out in extra-time to Spartan South Midlands Football League Division 1 visitors Biggleswade (step 6) whilst Redbridge fell to SSMFL Premier division step 5 counterparts Colney Heath.

There were three matches in the league, all of which resulted in a home win with the away team failing to find the back of the net. Both Barking and Stansted scored three, against Clapton and West Essex respectively whilst Basildon United, with a 1-0 win, prevented Hullbridge Sports from potentially going back to the top of the table.

During the week, Barking, Basildon United and Redbridge (at the expense of fellow ESL Side Waltham Forest) progressed to the third round of the BBC Essex Senior Cup.
