By mauling West Essex (5-0) and winning at Takeley (1-0) on Saturday, where Ben O'Brien made his 265th appearance and now lies 7th in their all-time list, Barking secured maximum points this week and, as a result, sit pretty at the top of the table.

Southend Manor also collected maximum points with home wins against Redbridge (4-2) and Ilford (3-0). On Saturday, Redbridge got the midweek defeat out of their system by defeating Tower Hamlets (5-2).



Waltham Forest only picked up 66% of their possible points as they sneaked past Sporting Bengal United (1-0) in the week and failed to prevent Hullbridge Sports (2-2) from snatching a share of the spoils with a late equaliser (left). Barkingside and West Essex also had to be content with a point apiece (1-1). Sporting Bengal United failed to increase their points tally as they lost their second game of the week to Stansted (1-3).

After being comprehensively beaten in midweek by FC Romania (4-0), Eton Manor can consider themselves a tad unlucky on Saturday when they lost to a solitary Clapton goal which was timed as 108 minutes! Clapton also picked up three points a few days earlier when they beat Old Spotted Dog tenants London Bari by the odd goal in five. There was another high scoring game at the Old Spotted Dog when Sawbridgeworth Town, who shipped four goals against Enfield 1893 (4-2) in the week, bounced back to take all the points against London Bari by the odd goal in seven.

The fortunes of Burnham Ramblers, who beat Basildon United (1-0) in the week were reversed on Saturday as the former went down to Haringey & Waltham (2-1) who were playing their first official home game of the season at the Terence McMillan Stadium which was passed for use by The FA in the week and The Bees who came away from Wadham Lodge with maximum points (3-0).

There were three matches involving ESL clubs in the BBC Essex Senior Cup during the week with Hullbridge Sports, Stansted and Ilford (who disposed of Takeley) progressing to the next round.

Barking beat leaders, Take over at top

Takeley 0 Barking 1

Barking took over at the top of the Essex Senior League table with a hard-fought victory over previous leaders Takeley at Station Road. Blues made the trip up the M11 on the back of a 5-0 win over tenants West Essex at Mayesbrook Park in midweek, their fourth successive clean sheet in the league. And that defensive solidity proved key once again for joint managers Glen Golby and Steve Willis as they kept the home side off the scoreboard and netted the only goal of the game seven minutes before the interval.

The winner came from a likely source too as Petrit Elbi's cross from the left found James Peagram in the box to head home and find the net for the 15th time already this season for the 42nd goal of his Barking career, in only 39 appearances, while faltering Takeley suffered a third successive loss in all competitions, following their FA Vase exit against Biggleswade and Essex Senior Cup loss to Ilford.

Blues visit Haringey & Waltham Development next weekend, then host Cockfosters in the first-ever meeting between the two clubs for a London Senior Cup tie on Tuesday October 11.
