It was a very busy week again as most clubs played midweek fixtures.

Barking increased their advantage at the top of the table with home wins against Barkingside (3-1) on Tuesday and Haringey & Waltham (6-1) just three nights later. The latter had previously enjoyed a share of the spoils in a midweek jaunt to Sawbridgeworth Town (0-0). Following their loss, Barkingside went on to do Barking a favour on Saturday when they returned from Waltham Forest with maximum points (3-1).



## Ballers v West Essex (2-0)

Eton Manor were involved in two high scoring thrillers when they won by the odd goal in nine at Basildon United during the week and then sharing six goals at Redbridge. The Bees then stung Sporting Bengal United, who had picked up a point in a goal-less draw at Tower Hamlets on Monday evening, by notching three goals in the last ten minutes to secure their win (3-1) on Saturday.

With Takeley getting an injury time equaliser and Wadham Lodge winning 2-1, Enfield 1893 only picked up one of the six points available to them. The latter had a midweek home defeat (0-2) at the hands of Clapton. Ilford dropped points at Redbridge (0-2) and prevented Takeley from increasing their tally with a 2-0 home win.

Burnham Ramblers, who surrendered a two-goal lead in their midweek home fixture with West Essex, saw their weekend game against Sawbridgeworth Town abandoned after 87 minutes – they were trailing 2-3 at the time – whilst West Essex went down to Hullbridge Sports (0-2) who returned from their midweek game at Stansted with a point (1-1). Stansted finished off the week with a home win (2-1) over FC Romania.

Yet again, Clapton boasted the highest attendance of the weekend when 476 saw them go down to a solitary goal against visitors Southend Manor who have now won five league matches on the spin only sitting behind leaders Barking in the 'Form' table on goal-difference. Their last league defeat was the reverse fixture against The Tons back in September. They also picked up their midweek points at the Old Spotted Dog with a 4-2 win over London Bari.

## Barking sub Delgado sinks rivals

Substitute Omari Delgado netted a hat-trick to help Barking hit Haringey & Waltham for six in their Essex Senior League encounter at Mayesbrook Park. Delgado was making only his second appearance off the bench for the club and officials believe he is the first player to score a treble before making his first start in Barking's long history.

James Peagram added a brace to take his tally for the season to 18, with Joe Pearman also on target as Blues moved six points clear at the top of the table as a result of their latest triumph, with their rivals due to play the following day.

They took the lead on the quarter-hour mark when Peagram headed home a corner at the far post and doubled their advantage two minutes later when Pearman's long-range effort deceived Sam Whitby in the visiting goal. The visitors hit back late in the first half as Jackson broke clear and rounded Lewis Greene, who was making his first start of the campaign in goal, to halve the deficit at the break.

The second half was only five minutes old when Delgado opened his account and restored the two-goal cushion and Blues piled on more pressure, with Pearman flashing wide and Peagram having penalty appeals turned down. Barking went 4-1 up when Peagram burst through to score his second of the night on 73 minutes, before Delgado chipped Whitby for number five and completed his hat-trick six minutes later.

Barking's lead was cut to five points the following day, but they have five games in hand on their closest rivals and would still be top if their other challengers won their matches in hand on Blues.

## ESSEX SENIOR LEAGUE ROUND-UP: Southend Manor run goes on as Hullbridge secure points

SOUTHEND Manor got the better of Clapton to continue their excellent recent form in the Essex Senior League.

Sam Short got the goal that decided the match. It was a well worked strike and put the away side ahead in front of a good crowd at Clapton.

And it delighted manager Stuart Marshall.

"I can't ask any more of the lads," he said. "They put their bodies on the line and I can say they left nothing out there. The togetherness is a pleasure to watch."

Ashley Pibworth continued his scoring run as Hullbridge Sports beat West Essex 2-0.

Sports were looking for a much-needed victory as they looked to return to winning ways in the league.

They had an early let off after some poor defending required goalkeeper Charley Aldis into action.

Player/manager Rob Hodgson hit the bar but three minutes later they had the lead as Charlie Little's centre found the head of Pibworth who scored.

Harry Skinner hit the bar as the hunt for the second goal went on but it looked as though West Essex had levelled the scores with just minutes to go, only for the flag to deny the hosts.

Hodgson got a late second for the visitors.

Basildon were 3-1 winners against Sporting Bengal United.

The Bees were struggling to break down a resilient Sporting Bengal, despite their loftier league position.

But goals from Lee Delf, Ayoola Motentel and Yaw Danso were enough in the end.
