Clapton enjoyed two away victories, both of which were clean sheets, at Ilford (2-0) and high flying Basildon United (0-1). It was not a very good week for The Bees as a single point obtained in the high-scoring home fixture against Tower Hamlets (4-4) saw them slide down the table.

Haringey & Waltham found themselves involved in two high scoring home games losing to West Essex (1-5) and league leaders Barking (3-4).

Meanwhile, Waltham Forest were in two games with a 4-1 score line; the first was in their favour against Enfield 1893 whilst the second was a defeat at Southend Manor who bounced back from a rather disappointing midweek defeat at Redbridge (1-2). The latter shared the spoils at Burnham Ramblers (2-2).

In the two games played in Cheshunt, FC Romania put Tower Hamlets to the sword (3-1) at Theobalds Grove whilst, down the road at Goffs Lane Enfield 1893 picked up the points with a win over Eton Manor.

Sporting Bengal United went down by the odd goal in five at home to Ilford whilst Stansted put the disappointment of a midweek cup defeat behind them to comprehensively beat Wadham Lodge (5-2).

Stansted and Tilbury met in the BBC Essex Senior Cup 3rd Round with the latter progressing to the next round following a penalty shoot-out. Whilst in the Herts Senior Cup 1st Round Sawbridgeworth Town lost to Hadley (1-2) and Eton Manor went out to Ware, who were playing their 230th competition game in contrast to The Manor's 2nd, (2-3) after going ahead through a 5-second goal scored by Joe Bricknell. Ware now have just two games to go before hitting their 5000th fixture since 1892.

Barking beat basement boys in thriller

Haringey & Waltham 3 Barking 4

Joe Pearman's late winner enabled Essex Senior League leaders Barking to defeat bottom club Haringey & Waltham in a seven-goal thriller at Terence McMillan Stadium.

Blues made the short trip across east London having suffered only their second league loss of the season a week earlier to Sawbridgeworth at Mayesbrook Park.

And they took control with a pair of first-half goals as Omari Delgado netted his 10th goal on only his fifth start for the club and Jay Taylor also found the net for

the first time for the club, before the home side hit back just before the interval.

Blues restored their two-goal cushion after the restart when Joe Staunton sent Petrit Elbi through to score, but Haringey & Waltham would not give up easily and forced their way back into the match to level.

Hopes of earning an unlikely point were shattered, though, as Pearman popped up with his seventh goal of the season to give the visitors all three and keep them eight clear of Takeley at the top of the table.

Barking turn their attentions to the Essex Senior Cup in midweek, as they welcome Grays Athletic to Mayesbrook Park for a last-16 tie, postponed last week as their rivals had an FA Trophy replay which took precedent.

Clapton maintained their impressive recent form to claim a third successive win and third clean sheet in a row in the Essex Senior League.

Tons travelled to the Stuart Bingham Stadium to take on the Bees, having run out 2-0 winners at Ilford in midweek. Success over Allan Fenn's Foxes came on the back of a 1-0 win at Takeley and Tons enjoyed more success on their travels thanks to a 10th-minute header from Siao Blackwood, who nodded home from a corner.

The visitors saw Lanre Vigo sent off for two bookable offences, but survived a lengthy, nine-minute spell of stoppage time to claim three more points and remain in sixth place. Kristian Haighton took to social media to show his delight, tweeting: "Another Win, another clean sheet!! Was a pleasure to Captain and play in front of the amazing fans!"

Tons return to action next weekend when Barkingside visit the Old Spotted Dog, but fans can get special reduced admission of just £4 to watch Barkingside take on Stansted, who are managed by former Clapton boss Michael Walther, at Cricklefield Stadium on Monday (November 7). Michael Ogboin's double sealed victory for the visitors and sent Bari to a fifth defeat in their last eight league and cup matches. The loss leaves Bari in 16th place, with 20 points from their 17 matches played to date, and they return to action on Tuesday when they make the trip to mid-table outfit Sawbridgeworth Town.
