Gorleston 0 Basildon United 1

(Match abandoned after 90 minutes due to tragic circumstances)

The Vase tie at Emeralds Park was abandoned with a few minutes remaining after a Gorleston spectator, later confirmed to be the father of hosts keeper Tauren Molloy's partner John Bailey, collapsed and died after the Bees had scored in the 87th minute.

Before the tragic circumstances materialised the tie was well balanced although the visitors were reduced to ten men with some ten minutes remaining when George Whitby was shown a second yellow for bringing down a Gorleston player just outside the box.

However, the ten men managed to net what they thought could be the winning goal when, completely out of the blue, from a corner the ball broke to Nathan Dewberry outside the box and he struck an effort which took a deflection and flew in. It quickly became apparent a minute or two later though that the spectator had collapsed. The game continued into stoppage time, when it was suspended, whilst the staff present at the ground tried in vain to save the man's life. Sadly, despite resuscitating him three times, he died soon after the emergency services arrived.

A truly sad and tragic way for the day to end and unsurprisingly the match was abandoned with no decision, as yet, on whether the game is replayed or the result stands although right now it's rather insignificant and everyone's thoughts are with the friends and family of the deceased man and the club on such a tragic day in Norfolk.

The Great Yarmouth "Mercury" reported that *the club's secretary [Gorleston] Colin Bray said he wanted to pass on his and the club's condolences to the man's family and friends.*

"We have asked the league for their permission, as a mark of respect, to call off Tuesday's match against Team Bury in the League Challenge Cup," he added.

Mr Bray praised the ambulance staff and club officials for their response.

"They were great and did everything they could. The paramedics said everyone at the club did a terrific job but nothing more could be done."

Richard Mann, The Bees secretary advised me that "at the moment the match is due to be replayed next Saturday which is what the FA rules state in such a situation."

"If Gorleston decide to forfeit the match that is up to them and they can do that according to FA rulings but at the moment the match is due to be replayed."

He was understandably shocked and asked me to pass on his, and Basildon United FC's, condolences.

In the other Buildbase FA Vase fixture, with Essex Senior League interest, FC Romania drew 1-1 with Tring Athletic.

For the first time this season the weather contrived to cause a number of postponements during the week. Ultimately, only three matches survived where Barking and Barkingside progressed to the second Round of The Gordon Brasted Memorial Trophy with regulation time victories over Clapton and Basildon United respectively. West Essex also progressed via the lottery of a penalty shoot-out at London Bari.

The highest scoreline aggregate of the day was at the Leslie Field Stadium where, Barkingside came back from 2-0 down to win 5-2 against Burnham Ramblers.

Barking remain top recording a 4-0 win at Wadham Lodge. Hot on their heels, Southend Manor, who now have skylight between them and third placed Takeley, won by the same scoreline at Sporting Bengal United.

London Bari grabbed all three points at home to Redbridge with a 2-1 victory a feat emulated by Eton Manor and Clapton at Stansted and Waltham Forest respectively.

Enfield 1893 won 3-1 at Ilford and Hullbridge Sports put three past Tower Hamlets without reply.

Barking reserves scored a resounding 5-2 victory against Erith Town Reserves in the London Senior Trophy (formerly the London Intermediate Cup) and will be at home again to Bridon Ropes 1st X1 in the quarter final on February 4th . The winners will be at home in the semi-final to the 1st X1 of Tooting Bec or Balham.
