Barking get better of Tower Hamlets

Barking 3 Tower Hamlets 1

Barking bounced back from a rare defeat to take another step towards the Essex Senior League title with victory over lowly Tower Hamlets at Mayesbrook Park. Coming off a disappointing 2-0 loss to FC Romania in midweek, the blues put out a strong side with academy prospect Max Watters included in the starting line-up **despite making his England Schoolboys' debut in Scotland the night before.**

Barking looked comfortable in possession very early on, moving the ball around well in midfield and passing out of defence. And the first goal of the afternoon came on 12 minutes when a 25-yard floated free-kick from top goalscorer James Peagram evaded everybody in the box and curled into the bottom corner of the net for his 42nd of the season.

The hosts continued to control the majority of the possession and began to look very settled after their first goal, with Omari Delgado glancing a shot just wide of the post. And they doubled their lead five minutes before the break as Delgado produced a composed left-footed finish across the keeper into the bottom corner, after a solid run and slotted pass from Watters, to claim his 20th goal of the campaign.

Tower Hamlets kept a very good shape and continuously made the most of the few opportunities they had, pulling a goal back 10 minutes after the break. A short corner was played to the edge of the 18-yard box and met brilliantly by Rahim Adama Bamba who made a perfectly timed run **to slot the ball into the far corner of Rob Hatton's net to halve the deficit.**

Barking ran into more trouble after the goal as Tower Hamlets grew in confidence, launching increased attacks from the right side. But the visitors could not sustain that pressure as Blues sent on fresh legs in Matheus Santos, who was a constant threat, Paul Oshin and player-manager Glen Golby. The substitutes took advantage of a tiring Tower Hamlets defence and when a long goal kick from Hatton was flicked on by Golby to Peagram in the box, the visiting keeper was forced to push his shot over the bar. The resulting corner picked out Oshin, and he **cushioned the ball into the bottom corner for Barking's third to keep them five points clear of Clapton at the top of the table,** with two matches in hand.

Ilford fought back from a goal down to take the Essex Senior League points against Southend Manor at Cricklefield Stadium. **Allan Fenn's Foxes** had won six of their previous eight outings, but were looking to bounce back after a 2-1 loss against West Essex at Mayesbrook Park a week earlier. They had lost 3-0 at Southend when the sides met in October, but beaten their rivals 2-0 in a league cup tie in December thanks to **Wale Odedoyin's double.**

Manor gained the upper hand early on in this latest meeting, though, as Michael Hopkins put them ahead with only eight minutes played. But Ilford rallied to draw level through Lithuanian Karolis Atutis, before Luke McLeavy claimed their winner.

Victory lifted Fenn's men up to eighth place in the table, with games in hand on all of the teams above them in the standings. Fenn tweeted: **"Extremely proud of everyone involved with @ilfordcfoxes. On & off the pitch, a credit to the club. Boys dug deep & got the 3 points #Foxes."** Ilford are set to play host to mid-table Waltham Forest on Wednesday, when another win could see them leapfrog Sawbridgeworth into seventh place.

From The Archives...

Readers may have noticed that in digging into the archives for games on the same Saturdays in years past that I have missed out on 1978.

Unfortunately, my records are very sparse for that season but I would not wish to disregard the fact that this was the heyday of Basildon United in a 16 club League and they certainly became the new force in the ESL now that Billericay Town had left for the Athenian League. They took the Championship by five points from Tiptree United and were beaten just the once and that was in their penultimate game of the season, 0-2 by Heybridge Swifts.

The Bees also were the first ever club to achieve the double when they won the League Cup 3-0 on May 20th at the expense of Bowers United with Tony Selwyn becoming the leading scorer on 30 goals and Dickie Brooks in the middle.

Ford United won the Sportsmanship Trophy and Basildon United also won the Essex Elizabethan Trophy, beating Isthmian League Rainham Town (How many remember them ?) in a replay at Gardiners Close after a draw at Deri Park.

Although I cannot specifically recall March 4th 1978, Basildon United went on to win the Reserve Division, Heybridge Swifts the Cup and Witham Town, the Shield.

At the AGM on 29th June, East Ham United were elected for season 1978-1979 and there was just the one wobble that season when Woodford Town Reserves withdrew on December 19th 1977; their last game having been on 8th October.
