Turgut Esendagli – In Memoriam

Turgut Esendagli sadly passed away on October 12th. The Waltham Forest Chairman joined the club whilst they were still groundsharing with Ilford at Cricklefields. Within a year he had steered the club back to their former Wadham Lodge base, instigated the setting up of a Ladies and Veteran teams at the club and was actively involved in preparing for Waltham Forest's upcoming 150th anniversary season.

Mr Esendagli was a former President of the Turkish Society Football Federation and was combining being Chairman of Waltham Forest with coaching the Crawley Town U23 team at the time of his untimely death.

Outside of football Turget was also actively involved in local politics having served as a Local Councillor for Enfield. His funeral last Thursday was well-attended with Joan Ryan, an Enfield MP; the Mayor of Enfield and a representative from the Turkish Consulate in London being amongst the mourners.

Alan Brazil Ended Playing Career in the Essex Senior League



There was quite a stir in the 1989/90 season when former Scottish International and Ipswich Town favourite signed for Stambridge United in a tremendous coup. Brazil had also turned out for Tottenham Hotspur, Manchester United and Coventry City, before finishing off his professional career at QPR.

His debut came on Saturday 23rd September 1989 in a league match v Stansted and his presence and expertise on the field was soon felt when, having gone in at half time 0-1 down, he came out, showed outstanding form, that I was privileged to witness and scored twice in a 3-2 victory. Dave Goulding completed the scoring.

On the next Saturday he scored again in a 1-0 Essex Senior Trophy win over Walthamstow Pennant. He scored twice in a 7-2 away success against East Ham United on October 21st followed by two of his goals helping Stambridge to a 7-1 away victory at Maldon Town on November 4th.

Alan Brazil's short tenure at Stambridge certainly boosted their record with ten games without defeat up until a 0-2 reverse by Ford United on January 6th 1990. He was not about when Stambridge had their floodlight inaugural on Tuesday 13th March against Southend Manor with a record attendance of 200 witnessing a 4-1 Southend Manor victory. Stambridge are now a Sunday League team and another club, Corinthians of the Essex Olympian League now play at their ground. As for Alan Brazil he went on to launch a media career presenting TalkSport's Breakfast Show.

Friday 20th October

Buildbase FA Vase First Round Proper

Holland 1 Great Wakering Rovers 2

Rovers netted late on to sneak victory against Holland in Clacton to get through to the next round of the FA Vase. The first chance of the game brought the opening goal as the visitors led inside ten minutes when Richmond converted from the spot after a foul on Carter but the hosts hit back to equalise when Eaton fired home. And that looked like that would be that and extra time would be needed but as the game was getting stretched the visitors struck with four minutes remaining when Nash stabbed home a corner and end Holland's maiden Vase campaign.

Saturday 21st October

Buildbase FA Vase First Round Proper

Basildon United 0 Biggleswade 2

The Bees are out of the FA Vase after falling to two second half goals from Spartan South Midlands Premier side Biggleswade at The Hive. The visitors edged ahead in the second period before sealing the deal with ten minutes left when great play by Ryan Inskip saw him find Lee Northfield who made no mistake and saw his side through.

Beckenham Town 2 Sawbridgeworth Town 0

The Robins are out of the Vase after losing to Beckenham Town in Kent. A Branco free kick put the hosts ahead before Archie Johnson doubled the Kent sides lead and saw the hosts progress to Round Two.

Burnham Ramblers 0 Leighton Town 1

Ramblers three game winning run came to an end as they crashed out of the Vase after a home defeat to Bedfordshire side Leighton Town at Leslie Field. The only goal came in the 68th minute when Lorrel Smith netted and it was enough for the visitors to take victory and progress.

Halstead Town 2 Tower Hamlets 2 (aet; Tower Hamlets won 6-5 on penalties)

Hamlets are through to Round Two of the Vase after a dramatic penalty shoot win over Halstead Town at Rosemary Lane. The hosts led on 13 minutes through James Reagan but three minutes before half time Luke With equalised for the visitors to see the sides go in level at the half. The second half failed to find a goal meaning the match went to extra time and with six minutes of it remaining With put Hamlets in front, however four minutes into stoppage time Jordan Pavitt took the game to penalties with a last gasp leveller for the hosts. However Hamlets regrouped to win the shootout and progress into the next round.

Hullbridge Sports 1 Colney Heath 1 (aet)

A replay will be required on Tuesday after Hullbridge and Colney Heath could not be separated after 120 minutes of football at Lower Road. London Lions were delighted with their 197 crowd that turned up to see their FA Vase 1st Round tie with Clapton yesterday – it was their biggest ever attendance although most of the crowd was made up of Tons supporters. However it was London Lion who progressed with a 3-2 victory that puts them into the 2nd Round of the FA Vase for only the second time in their history.

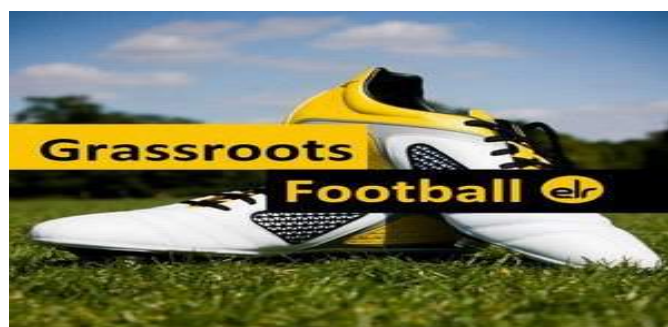
