### Premier Division Round-Up

#### Premier Division

##### Barkingside P-P Wadham Lodge

Today's match at Cricklefield was postponed due to an unplayable pitch.

#### Great Waking Rovers 1 Takeley 0

Waking took the points in a real battle at Burroughs Park. Substitute Neil Richmond's late penalty ended up giving the hosts the win though they really had to work for it as Takeley had chances of

their own in a match played in difficult conditions. Wakering grabbed their sixth straight league victory and in the process gained ground on second-placed side FC Romania.

#### **Hullbridge Sports P-P West Essex**

The match at Lower Road was postponed due to an unplayable pitch.

#### **Sawbridgeworth Town 1 Enfield 1893 3**

Enfield grabbed a marvellous victory at Crofters against a Sawbridgeworth side that have now lost two straight. The visitors went ahead in the 19th minute when a great ball in by Barrett found Ben Bradbury at the back post who duly converted, however the hosts levelled in similar fashion in the 29th minute through Billy Skinner, meaning the sides went into the break level. But just before the hour mark the visitors retook the lead when Bradbury netted with a superb solo effort, and then in the 73rd minute sealed the win when Joe Johnson curled home delightfully from range and give the visitors a vital three points.

#### **Sporting Bengal United 2 Southend Manor 3**

Steve Carvell and Tanvir Ahmed both netted for hosts Sporting Bengal United, however they could not follow up their superb midweek win with another three points as they fell to a narrow defeat against Southend Manor at Mile End Stadium. The visitors had to battle for the win though in tough conditions, although Rhys Fatt fired Manor into the lead in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute and then a minute later keeper Klinton Makayabo kicked the ball from his own area that ended up sailing over his counterparts head and landing in the back of the net. Carvel was able to pull one back before the break, but Alfie Lindfield looked like he had secured the points when he scored in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute but Sporting Bengal pulled one back five minute later. However Manor went on to take a welcome three points, but the win was marred by two bad injuries which won't help their cause going forward. Sporting Bengal on the other hand may be looking over their shoulders again after this defeat.

#### **Stansted 2 Clapton 3**

Clapton edged a thriller at a muddy Hargrave Park against Stansted to climb into fifth spot after Takeley lost at Wakering. Jay Morris put the visitors ahead with a superb free kick before Dylan Ebengo doubled the Tons lead. Stansted pulled one back through Ryan Ramsey before Jeffrey Cobblah restored the visitors two goal cushion. Jack West was then sent off for the hosts for a second yellow and the hosts missed a spot kick too. Stansted then set up a grandstand finish when pulling another back through Julien Lloyd; however the Tons held on to inflict only Stansted's second defeat in seven since the turn of the year.

### **Waltham Forest 1 FC Romania 1**

Elias Siligato scored on his debut for Waltham Forest as they held high flying FC Romania to a draw at Kitchener Road in Walthamstow. Vlad Sighiartau levelled the scores in the 52<sup>nd</sup> minute. Despite this result the gap to the bottom four is now only two points after Enfield's win at Sawbridgeworth, whilst FCR remain second, three points behind Redbridge but only a point ahead of third placed Great Wakering Rovers.

### **Woodford Town (2017) 5 Burnham Ramblers 2**

Braces from De'juane Taylor-Crossdale and Gamel Nfodjo plus a brilliant free kick from Andrea Mantovani saw Woodford Town hit five at home to Burnham Ramblers at Goffs Lane. Karl Swanborough and Robert Bagnell notched the Burnham replies. The hosts remain 10th but for the visitors it's six defeats on the spin and they are now just a point above the bottom four after an alarming 2018 so far.



The Semi Final draw for the BBC Essex Premier Cup saw Waltham Abbey Res. handed a home tie against Buckhurst Hill. The visitors were relegated from the Prokit UK Essex Olympian League's Premier Division last season but look like they will make an immediate return as they currently sit top of Division One. Last time out they disposed of Kelvedon Hatch, however Waltham Abbey ended May & Baker E.C. run in the previous round and with home advantage could be favoured to reach the Final. The last Reserve team to land the Essex Premier Cup was Witham Town Res. in 2005/06. The other Semi Final pits Old Southend, from Division One of the Olympian League, against local rivals Catholic United. The visitors ply their trade in the Olympian League's Premier Division and they have reached the Final twice in the twice in the last three seasons, winning the competition last season but then having to hand the cup to Harold Wood Athletic due to a player technicality.

## Waltham Forest Announce New Manager & Barkingside Appoint An Assistant Manager

There was a managerial change at Waltham Forest this week as the club parted company with Qayum Shakoor and then promptly offered the job to Ryan Maxwell, who had been at the club last season as a coach. The new manager has also registered as a player and has played for a host of National League and National League South clubs such as Dagenham & Redbridge, Basingstoke Town, Margate, Bishop's Stortford and Tonbridge Angels. Maxwell has also played professionally for Reading, Hamilton Academical, Raith Rovers and Llanelli, playing for the Welsh club in the UEFA Cup. He has the task of getting Waltham Forest as far away from the relegation zone and has made a clutch of signings including Lee Flynn, Gus Douglas, Ahmed Mohammed, Harrison Seetah and Prince Madu. One of the new signings, Christian Owusu, joined having played for Bishop's Stortford and Cheshunt this term, and he scored his first goal in Waltham forest colours yesterday afternoon as the Stags held FC Romania to a 1-1 draw.

Barkingside have also made a managerial appointment as Ray Bartlett once again teams up with Michael Walther, acting as Assistant Manager. He was instrumental in the Tons reaching 2<sup>nd</sup> spot last season and helped bring players such as Ryan Reed, Steven Sardinha, Jay Knight, Quincy Egbajale and Jay Morris to Clapton. Speaking in the Barkingside programme recently Bartlett said: "I'm very excited to be back." Having taken time out from the game after stints at Clapton and then Wadham Lodge, Bartlett went on to say: "When Mike called me last week, I knew I had to say yes as I've worked with him before and he was the one that brought me in at Clapton and I learned a lot from him" Barkingside are not out of the relegation danger zone just yet but with Walther and Bartlett now working together again means that the Cricklefield outfit will be hoping to end the season as high up the table as possible.

## Hackney Wick Announce New Ground For Next Season

Hackney Wick may be battling for their Essex Senior League status but the club have recently announced that their new stadium from next season will be the London Marathon Community Track Stadium, which is in close proximity to West Ham United's London Stadium. The club have been ground sharing at Old Spotted Dog this season and will share the ground next term with Altis FC. Speaking to the Hackney Gazette, Bobby Kasanga said that despite heavy competition and financial restrictions the Wickers gained the tenancy because the club is a local charity that is heavily involved with guiding youths away from the gang life that plagues many inner city London boroughs. Kasanga went on to say: "We said we can't afford to pay ridiculous amounts, however if they look at what we do, we're a community football club, were local and we want to take this." Whatever happens come the end of the season, the Wickers have now secured a home closer to their local area that could be the stirrup they need to move them forward.



## Woodford Town 2017 Also Announce Ambitious Plans

A recent Woodford Town 2017 article in the East London & West Essex Guardian mentioned how the club Chairman Tony Scott has given up his day job in an attempt to get the club returning to the London Borough of Redbridge. The photo was taken outside the old Snakes Lane ground which the club vacated in 1993. Since that time the ground has fallen into disuse but is nonetheless still there, having not been built on and could therefore be a likely venue for the club to pursue. Scott told the Guardian: "To get a ground would be the ultimate dream, it would be unbelievable. The committee have got football backgrounds and could make it work. It would mean the world to us."

Woodford Town plans also include establishing boys' youth teams, a girl's team plus a disabled team. The club currently groundshare with FC Broxbourne Borough. As a youth I used to spend a lot of time at Snakes Lane as Woodford Town were one of my local clubs. I even attended the FA Cup 1<sup>st</sup> Round tie between Woodford Town and Orient in 1986/87, with Paul Williams at the time turning out in Woodford colours before eventually making his way into the Football League with Charlton Athletic. It could be a case of watch this space, but it seems Woodford Town are committed to returning nearer to their spiritual home.
